Information Sheet: The Good Book Club: This is an example from one church of integrating daily reading with Sunday worship

How might you encourage a whole congregation to read the whole Bible in a year? One way one congregation sought to do this was by incorporating into its main Sunday worship a programme of sermons and readings that took the congregation from Genesis to Revelation in 12 months.

The **Sunday themes** took the congregation through the Bible in book order. Each week those attending were encouraged to read sections of Scripture for themselves with the **weekly reading assignment**.

The scheme below is based on just 32 weeks with time over Christmas and Easter to catch up but it also offers space for other special Sundays [see also Week 17] and holiday times. It can be used as flexibly so as to fit different situations.
