# Pope Francis and the Archbishop of Canterbury to commission bishops in support of ecumenical summit 'Growing Together'

During the week, Pope Francis and the Archbishop of Canterbury will commission Catholic and Anglican bishops for joint mission, as part of the ecumenical dialogue summit "Growing Together" run by IARCCUM.

The programme includes the following:

# Thursday, January 25

# **Morning**

The Archbishop of Canterbury will preside and preach at Anglican Eucharist at San Bartolomeo All'Isola on Tiber Island (Sanctuary of the New Martyrs).

# <u>Afternoon</u>

Pope Francis and the Archbishop of Canterbury will commission Catholic and Anglican bishop pairs taking part in the ecumenical summit "Growing Together". They will send the bishops out for joint mission and witness. <u>The commissioning will take part during Vespers near the tomb of the Apostle Paul (Basilica of St Paul Outside the Walls).</u>

This will be a significant moment, symbolic for Anglican-Catholic bonds and advancing ecumenical dialogue. It will be the second time that the Pope and the Archbishop of Canterbury have commissioned Anglican and Catholic bishop pairs since 2016 (which happened in the context of the first IARCCUM summit).

A pilgrimage visit to the church of San Gregorio al Celio, from where the first Archbishop of Canterbury was sent to England by Pope Gregory the Great in 597. The bishops of "Growing Together" will meet for prayer at the site.
